 - To work with individual children and adolescents within the intensive therapeutic family work
- To be involved in assessment of complex contact arrangements and mediation
- To liaise with social services departments, educational establishments and other referring/relevant agencies

- To maintain full and accurate electronic case records of all work with children, families and professionals
- To independently write assessment and other reports
- To participate in individual supervision and group consultation with external supervisors
- To participate in PAC's professional and user training programmes
- To possibly attend relevant training and study courses outside PAC
- To facilitate training courses on adoption related matters for adoptive parents, professionals
- To be pro-active in publicising PAC's Child & Family Service
- To adhere to PAC's Statement of Purpose, mission and values and work in accordance with all PAC's policies and procedures.
- To carry out projects or perform other duties, either on PAC's initiative or in response to requests from local authorities/users, for example: Life Story Books, running groups.
