Rhythm and Resonance: safe connections within trauma-based attachments

Joy Hasler is a music therapist, teacher and founder of Catchpoint. She is an adoptive parent and has been a short and long-term foster carer. Joy has given presentations and run workshops in conferences internationally and is a published author/illustrator of books about parenting traumatised children. At Catchpoint, Joy heads a team of arts and play therapists who have developed a trauma recovery model of therapy with an attachment focus.

Attachment is a two-way rhythmic process of mis-attunement and attunement between the parent and child. Attuning with traumatised children is almost impossible without being affected by the trauma. Rhythm and Resonance is an interactive day looking at how understanding the science of frequencies and resonance can assist in building positive attachments, and how working with natural rhythms can help bonding.
