Louis Sydney is a child and adult psychotherapist and specialist adoption consultant at Adoptionplus as well as an independent trainer, clinical supervisor and consultant. He has worked with adopted or fostered children and families for over ten years and was a family therapist, trainer and offered consultation at Family Futures for over nine years. He has also trained in Theraplay®, Dan Hughes' Dyadic Developmental Therapy and Somatic Experiencing® (a body and trauma focussed approach to therapy).

The day will focus on supporting parents who are parenting sibling groups and meeting their multiple needs. Current theory on attachment, trauma and neuroscience will inform the approach to the day.

The training will specifically address how to manage sibling conflict and rivalry and reduce aggression and control amongst sibling groups.
