Large Sibling Group Adoption Research Study

I'm a doctoral candidate at Kingston University and searching for participants in a research study about the lived experiences of adopters and adopted children in large sibling groups. Currently recruiting people who adopted 3 or more children at once as well as people who were adopted with 2 or more of their siblings. Participants will be interviewed for approx. 90 minutes (audio recorded) at a time and place that is convenient to you. Participants must also be at least 18 years of age. You will receive anonymized key findings of the study once completed. The study has been reviewed by an independent group of people called the Faculty of Health, Social Care and Education Research Ethics Committee (FREC). They have given a favourable ethical opinion.

People who were adopted with 2 or more siblings together

Willing to be interviewed and audio recorded for 90 minutes

Must be at least 18 years of age and live in England or Wales
