Award winning adoption support agency PAC-UK joins national charity Family Action

National charity Family Action and PAC-UK are delighted to announce they formally merged on the 1 December 2018. Family Action provides some 150 community-based and national services including Early Years Services, services to support Children and Families, Adult Mental Health and Wellbeing Services, the National Schools Breakfast Programme and a UK-wide Grants programme. PAC-UK is England's largest Adoption Support Agency. It was recently judged Outstanding by Ofsted (for the third time in succession) and was the overall winner of the GSK Impact Award 2017. PAC-UK offers specialist therapy, advice, support, counselling and training for all affected by adoption and permanency. It will now join forces with Family Action to expand and enhance the portfolio of services provided by Family Action to people and families across the UK whilst building its own reach and impact with Family Action's support.

"Everyone at Family Action is delighted that PAC-UK and its excellent staff and services are joining us. PAC-UK is a wonderful addition to Family Action's "family" of services. PAC-UK will take our service provision in these areas to a new level and in return we offer broad expertise in working with children and families. Both organisations are committed to developing, delivering and promoting best practice in adoption support and we look forward to working with everyone to continue PAC-UK's important and valuable work which makes such a positive difference to the lives of so many people and families."

Jim Clifford OBE, Chair of PAC-UK said:

"PAC-UK was formed four decades ago because a number of people in the sector were concerned at the dearth of quality support for children, families and birth families in adoption. Its remit has developed over the years, always balancing maintaining high quality, affordable provision in mainstream areas with innovation, developing provision for newly emergent needs and using new techniques. Its recent work in the emergent area of child-on-parent violence, and on attachment and trauma in the classroom are just two examples of many. We recognised that, in an increasingly tough operating environment for public services, we needed to be more resilient, with greater depth of support services around us, if we were to maintain quality and develop further capacity. Joining Family Action enables us to do that whilst maintaining and developing all that is so special about PAC-UK."
