- Have an active interest in, and experience of, working as part of a multi-disciplinary team and able to advocate on behalf of children and adolescents.
- Have an active interest in working with people of different racial, ethnic and cultural backgrounds.
- Work closely with other team members.
- As the majority of your work will be delivered in school you need to be available during the day, however, please note that the post may also require twilight or evening work, on occasion.
- Travelling is a pre-requisite for this post and it is essential you have use of your own transportation.

- Either or both:
 - A professional qualification in the field of child/family or creative arts therapies, psychology, social work and registration with the relevant professional body e.g. HCPC, BACP, UKCP, UKRCP.
 - A qualification in the field of education/educational psychology and registration with the appropriate body where applicable.
- Experience, knowledge and skills in working with children who have experienced a difficult start in life, their families, carers and professional networks.
