Job title: Freelance Dramatherapist

Summary of job:

To deliver individual and group Dramatherapy to help schools and families to meet the needs of children struggling to manage in education.

Key tasks and responsibilities:

- 1. Deliver individual and group Dramatherapy to children in schools.
- 2. Facilitate consultations with school staff, parents and social workers to establish expected outcomes from the work and review progress.
- 3. To work collaboratively with the PAC-UK Child & Family Service to offer holistic support to families where applicable.
- 4. To work as part of the education team and participate in individual supervision and group consultation.
- 5. To record case notes as required.
- 6. To be able to evidence Family Action's values at all times, which underpin Family Action's mission of 'building stronger families' by:

- 8. Good organisational and time management skills.
- 9. Willingness to work in an innovative, flexible and creative way with children, families and schools.
- 10. Excellent communication and report writing skills.
- 11. Working proficiency in Microsoft Word.
- 12. Excellent interpersonal skills with the ability to relate to internal and external contacts at all levels, and to represent PAC-UK by telephone, in person and whilst attending PAC-UK or external evets.
