The key qualities are your communication, leadership and management skills, and an understanding of the impact of early trauma and loss.

You will have strong verbal and written communications skills, experience of delivering in person and virtual support and a relevant qualification in social work, psychology, psychotherapy, health, or education.



You will bring your own life and work experience to enrich and add to the leadership and management of a responsive and reflective service. Your interest, enthusiasm and sensitivity for the work will engage and reassure service users they are working with a professional who understands their situation and the issues they bring.

You may have experience working in drug and alcohol services, with young people leaving care, mediation or supporting those struggling with their mental health. You may be someone who has the transferable skills to grow and become part of a team of adoption and permanence specialists.
