


Are you dealing with Child-to-Parent Violence or challenging behaviour? Is your child adopted or under a Special Guardianship Order?

- Hold back from physical or verbal violence
- Increase positive presence in your child's life
- De-escalate conflicts
- Break the cycle of shame and silence
- Make changes in relating to your child in the long term
- Reduce distress for parent and child
- Feel more in control
- Recruit and use supporters
- Enjoy the benefits of being part of a group

Sue Dromey: NVR-UK Accredited Practitioner has worked in the field of fostering and adoption for over 40 years as an Integrative Child Psychotherapist, drama-therapist, trainer, Guardian ad Litem and social worker. She was Practice Manager with PAC-UK's Child and Family Service for 20 years. Sue has a special interest in therapeutic work, which addresses trauma in both children and their parents and integrating this with the principles of NVR. She was part of the team who has developed the PAC-UK Child to Parent Violence Project under a DfE grant. Sue works with trauma using EMDR (Eye Movement Desensitisation Reprocessing), AIT (Advanced Integrative Therapy) EFT (Emotional Freedom Technique) as well as creative therapies.

Veronique Faure: Child & Family Therapist. Veronique Faure studied and qualified in France as a Social Worker (HCPC Registered), and in the UK as an Integrative Arts Psychotherapist (UKCP Registered). She also obtained a Diploma in Child Psychotherapeutic Skills, and a Diploma in Clinical Supervision and Consultancy. She works privately with adults, children and adolescents, and as part of the Child and Family team at PAC-UK. She has 25+ years of multi-cultural inner-city professional experience, in the field of child protection, children in care and adoption. Amongst other things, she has managed a Residential and Outreach Family Assessment Centre; she has worked as a Court Expert in Family Proceedings, as a Child Protection Conference Chair and as an Independent Reviewing Officer; she also trained Child and Adolescent Psychotherapists for 7 years
