About Us

We have a team of highly skilled and experienced intermediaries and researchers who are passionate about adoption search and reunion and are proud to work within an agency rated as 'Outstanding' in all areas by Ofsted. They prepare and support you through the intermediary process, make a sensitive approach on your behalf and facilitate contact where this is wanted.

One of the key benefits of using a PAC-UK intermediary is the careful preparation that's undertaken. Making an approach in this way shows your relative that you have their welfare in mind; our intermediary will provide support not just to you, but also to the person approached who may not feel able to confide in anyone else.

In April 2020, the management of the Norcap Contact Register (NCR) transferred to Family Action, and is delivered by PAC-UK. This means we can check the NCR for links on behalf of adult adoptees and their relatives.

PAC-UK Private Intermediary Service

Our Private Intermediary Service provides specialist advice, guidance, tracing and intermediary services to support adults affected by adoption.

In the first instance, we recommend you contact us for a discussion about your particular situation and for information about the costs of the service. Concessionary rates are available if you are in receipt of benefits.

If you are an adult adoptee or a birth relative who wishes to reconnect with someone lost to adoption our Private Intermediary Service can:

- ✓ Trace who you are trying to find and make the first contact on your behalf
- ✓ Negotiate an outcome that balances your needs and those of others involved
- ✓ Where contact is wanted, support all parties through the initial stages
- ✓ Offer specialist guidance throughout (our intermediaries have a wealth of experience in this complex area)
- ✓ Provide support where contact is not wanted and discuss 'what next'

If you are a descendant or other relative of a deceased adopted adult our Private Intermediary Service can:

- ✓ Apply for information about your relative's birth history
- ✓ Search for records relating to their adoption
- ✓ Go on to search for living relatives if you wish to connect with your relative's birth family
